Sermon Reflection Questions

1. In what ways do we prioritize or neglect giving our best to God in our worship, time, talents, and resources? Reflect on moments when you might have given God less than your best. How can we strive to align our actions with the principle of giving God our utmost, both individually and as a community?
2. The people in Malachi's time struggled with insincere and unfaithful worship. Are there areas in our lives where we might be going through the motions in our relationship with God? How can we engage in honest self-examination to identify areas where our hearts might be distant from God? Share personal experiences when you have felt a lack of sincerity in your relationship with God and discuss ways to overcome this.
3. In Malachi 1, God rejects blemished sacrifices. In the New Testament, Paul calls us to present ourselves as living sacrifices (Romans 12:1). How can we apply this principle in our daily lives, offering our whole selves to God in our actions, decisions, relationships, and how can it guide us to live more intentionally for God's glory?
