### Reflection Questions

1. After the resurrection of Jesus, He sent us the Holy Spirit. How does the Holy Spirit help us? (Acts 6:8-10; John 14:26; Galatians 5:16-26)
2. Suffering is inevitable because we are living in a time of “already but not yet”. What are some of the sufferings that you are going through, or your loved ones are going through? How can looking to Scripture or looking to Jesus bring comfort in this difficult time? (Romans 8:26; James 1:12; Revelation 21:3-7)
3. Christ is undeniable because He is the way, and the truth, and the life (John 14:6). What are some of the ways that Jesus is “real” to you? What do you think about suffering for the sake of Christ?
