Reflection Questions

1. In Ephesians 1:3–14, Paul describes our destiny as being chosen, adopted, redeemed, and sealed by the Spirit. Which of these truths speaks most deeply to you today, and why?
2. We said God takes the initiative (He chooses us in Christ), but we must still respond to His grace. Looking at verses 11–13, how do you see both God’s initiative and our response working together in salvation?
3. The sermon ended with three steps toward fulfilling our destiny: discerning, accepting, and living into it. Which of these steps is most relevant for you right now, and what might it look like for you to walk in it this week?
