Sermon Reflection Questions

- 1. Paul speaks of the advantages of singleness in serving the Lord with undivided devotion (verses 32-35). How do you think being single can uniquely position someone to serve God? In what ways can married individuals also cultivate this kind of devotion in their lives?
- 2. In verses 29-31, Paul encourages believers to live with an eternal perspective, whether single or married. How can adopting this mindset impact our daily decisions and relationships? What practical steps can we take to live more purposefully with eternity in view?
- 3. Paul acknowledges that singleness and marriage are both gifts from God, but he emphasizes the freedom that singleness can bring (verses 36-40). How can we as a church better support those who are single, helping them to see their singleness as a purposeful and valuable calling?
