Reflection Questions

Ephesians 5:15-17 "¹⁵Be very careful, then, how you live — not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. ¹⁷Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is."

- ".. because the days are evil."
 Do you think the days are evil? What do you think these "evil days" in Ephesians 5 could mean? Has anything evil affected you personally or someone you know?
- 3. Pastor Daniel taught from Ephesians 5, the seven ways where a Christian (disciple) can walk wisely. Do you remember the seven ways? Which of these one or more ways of walking wisely with the Lord spoke to you, and how would you apply the lesson(s) to your life?
