2. What is one difficult conversation or act of courage God may be calling me to initiate for the sake of healing and restoration?

How might Nehemiah's example challenge me to confront issues — not harshly, but prayerfully and truthfully?

3. How is God inviting me to grow in integrity so that my life aligns with the message I proclaim?

Is there an area where my private life needs to catch up with my public commitments? What does living “before the fear of the Lord” look like for me this week?
