### Reflection Questions

1a) In 2 Kings, how was it determined whether a king did “what was right in the eyes of the Lord” (14:3, 15:3, 15:34) or if the king did “what was evil in the eyes of the Lord” (14:24, 15:9, 15:18, 15:24)? (Look at Ex 20:3, Deut 5:7)

1b) Why did this matter to God?

1c) Do you think it is a good thing or a bad thing that your faith is your own (that we all have our own faith journey)? Why?

2a) How do you think Uzziah’s failure (2 Chronicles 26:16-18) impacted his son, Jotham (2 Chronicles 26:21)?

2b) How do you respond to failure?

3a) How did God show King Jotham favour (2 Chronicles 27:3-6)?

3b) How does it make you feel knowing that God’s favour does not guarantee a long life? Why?

4) (For Parents) Rev Dr Wan encourages us to remember that God is in control, to love unconditionally, and to pray unceasingly for our children in rocky times. Which of these do you find the most challenging? Why?
