Reflection Questions

1. D — Desire Holiness

2. W — Worship with Thanksgiving

When and where will you intentionally “make room” for worship each day this week? List three graces from Ephesians 2:1–10 you will thank God for every day (e.g., made alive, raised with Christ, saved by grace).

3. E — Extend Peace

Who is one person you need to move toward to make peace or start reconciliation? What first step (phone call, message, coffee, apology) will you take within the next 48 hours (Ephesians 2:14–18)?
