Sermon Reflection Questions

- 1. In Luke 4:14-21, Jesus describes His mission, empowered by the Holy Spirit, to bring good news to the poor, proclaim freedom for prisoners, recovery of sight for the blind, and to set the oppressed free. How does your current life and activities align with these purposes? What are some practical steps you can take to better align your life with these intentions? Share an example of how you have seen or experienced the Holy Spirit working through you or someone else to serve others in need.
- 2. The sermon emphasized that the power of the Holy Spirit was given to enable us to lay down our lives for others, mirroring Jesus' example. What does laying down your life for others look like in your daily context (e.g., family, work, community)? Can you think of a situation in your life where you felt a nudge from the Holy Spirit to serve someone in need? How did you respond, and what was the outcome? If you missed an opportunity, how might you respond differently next time?
