Ephesians 2:8–10 (ESV) — "8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

- 1. Read Ephesians 1:1-2:7 for the context leading up to Ephesians 2:8-10. Consider who you are in Christ, what you have in Christ, and where you are in Christ. What do all these mean to you? How do all these prepare you for the purpose of doing good works for which you have been created in Christ? What is your response?
- 2. Review and reflect your own spiritual walk. What does salvation mean to you? What is your understanding of good works, the work of ministry and kingdom assignments? Is it for some only, or for all? Have you been walking in and working out the good works prepared beforehand by God for you?
