Sermon Reflection Questions

1. In Luke 17:11-17, only one of the ten healed lepers returns to give thanks to Jesus. Why do you think the other nine failed to come back? How does this passage challenge you to reflect on areas of your life where you may have overlooked thanking God?
2. The Samaritan leper not only thanked Jesus but also glorified God with a loud voice. What does this tell us about recognizing the source of our blessings? How can acknowledging God as the source deepen our gratitude? Application Point: In your daily routine, find one moment where you can pause and acknowledge God's provision. Share this acknowledgment with someone close to you, glorifying God in the process.
3. Jesus highlights the returning leper, saying, "Your faith has made you well." How does gratitude demonstrate faith and deepen your relationship with God? What are practical ways you can live out thankfulness in your daily life to reflect your faith?
