Reflection Questions

Read Habakkuk 1 as a group.

Did the Lord impress any truths from this chapter in your heart as you were reading it? Share.

2. One of the main theological truths from Chapter 1 is what we call "the problem of evil". How can God sit by and not do something about evil, especially society's seemingly overwhelming evil? And even when there seem to be judgment in the form of disasters, it seems that the truly bad guys will get away with it. Worse still, the wicked guys not only live, they continue to be prosperous.

What are the evils in the world today? Is God doing something or nothing about them? Is there something the church can do about? Is there something a Singaporean Christian can do about? Do bad guys really get away with it? Discuss.

 - 1 Samuel 3:1-10 (Samuel)
 - ii. Signs and Circumstances
 - Judges 6:36-40 (Gideon)
