Reflection Questions

1. Read aloud Luke 1:26-56 (perhaps 3 verses per DG member).

Did the Lord impress any truths, blessings, promises, commandments or warnings (not mentioned during the sermon) from this chapter of God's Word to you? Please share.

2. V28 "You who are highly favoured! The Lord is with you."

- **Do you consider yourself to have received God's favour? Do you sense that God has been / is with you?**
- **In the year past, recount how you have experienced God's favour and His presence.**
- **Moving ahead, where would you hope to receive God's favour?**

3. V30 "Do not be afraid ... you have found favour with God."

- **Where might God be nudging you toward obedience, but fear is holding you back?**
- **When is the last time you sensed the Lord leading you to do something in faith? What were your concerns?**

4. V34 "How will this be? ..."

Mary asked a sincere question without unbelief. **What honest questions or uncertainties do you need to bring to God, about faith or life?**

5. V35 “The Holy Spirit will come upon you ...”

Are you willing to say “yes” to God, that His Will according to His Word would be done unto you? What step of surrender is the Lord inviting you to take?
