Reflection Questions

1. Read Numbers 20:8-11. In what ways did Moses rebel against God's original call to speak to the rock as a means to provide water for the people? Moses' actions drew attention to his anger rather than God's mercy, and his deliverance rather than God's provision. He was seen as the saviour: the final judge and deliverer. What are some situations when you struggle with having a "*saviour complex*"?
2. What do you learn from this chapter about God's attitude toward disobedience?
3. In what ways is God shown to be holy (distinct, set apart, above and beyond us) in this text and how does this encourage and confront us in light of our regular unholiness?
