Reflection Questions

1. Read Daniel 7 aloud (perhaps 2 to 3 verses per DG member).

Was there anything from the chapter that was new to you, or had an impact on you? Was there anything that raised more questions in your mind?

2. You may refer to the following Bible passages that touch on the sovereignty of God:

Genesis 50:20 Psalm 135:5-6 Proverbs 16:9

Isaiah 46:8-11 Romans 8:28

How does knowing that **God is sovereign over all** – that He is above all and rules over all things all the time – affect the way you live your life?

- 3. How can the promise of God that in the end the wicked will be judged and the saints will reign with Jesus bring hope to the people who are suffering in the present?
