Sermon Reflection Questions

- 1. Reflecting on Samson's incredible strength, how do you see God's purpose in giving him this gift? How might Samson's misuse of his strength serve as a caution for us today about the dangers of wasting the gifts/talents God has given us in our lives?
- 2. Samson's downfall was often due to his uncontrolled desires, particularly his attraction to forbidden, ungodly relationships. How can we learn from Samson's mistakes when it comes to managing our own desires and maintaining our devotion to God?
- 3. In Judges 16, Samson's hair, a symbol of his Nazirite vow and God's consecration, was cut off, leading to his loss of strength. What areas of our lives might symbolize our commitment to God, and how can we ensure we are not compromising these areas for temporary pleasures or gains?
