Reflection Questions

1. Regarding the Gospel of John, name a verse/verses from this Gospel which you believe to be important to Christians/non-Christians/yourself). What does/do this verse(s) mean and why is it/they important?
2. Take turns to read John 1 aloud. Take five minutes to look at this chapter and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal a truth from God's Word into your heart and mind. Share (either in smaller groups or to the entire DG) the truth that the Lord has given to you.
3. In the New Testament in the original Greek language, some of the verses that use the Present Continuous Tense ("keep on" doing something) are:
 - i. Luke 11:9 (verbs: "ask, seek, knock")
 - ii. John 3:16 (verbs: "believe" and "have")
 - iii. Romans 9:1 (verbs: "tell" and "lie")
 - iv. Romans 3:28 (verb: "justify")
 - v. Ephesians 5:18 (verb: "fill")
 - vi. 1 John 3:9 (verb: "sin")

Discuss all the above verses – what is the Lord's intention that these verbs are written in the present continuous tense mean to our faith?

4. There are three stages of Belief: Credence, Confidence and Continuance. What are areas of beliefs in your life which are at these different stages? Share one area per stage.
