Reflection Questions

1. Read through Matthew 1:1-17 again. What stands out for you as you are reading this passage?
2. Consider a promise from God that you are waiting to see fulfilled. How can you trust in His faithfulness today, even when circumstances seem uncertain?
3. Are there areas in your life where God is gently calling you to repentance — to relinquish control and to allow Him to take over? (This could be areas where you are clinging on too tightly, or things that make you anxious or worried.)
4. What truths or promises from Scripture do you need to cling onto in this season?
5. Knowing that God weaves His purposes through people with flaws and messy stories, how might this change the way you regard your own journey — and the way you view the people around you?
6. Waiting can feel so isolating. Who are the people God may be inviting you to share your burdens with and to journey with you in this season? How can your group walk more honestly and lovingly with each other in your different seasons of waiting on the Lord?
