Ezra 7:6-10 | 8 February 2026 | Rev David Gwee

Sermon Questions

1. Some parents decline to have their children baptised till they can 'fully understand' and 'will find it meaningful'. We need to know that infant baptism is a covenant made between parents and God to bring up children in the ways of the Lord. Discuss some things parents can do to bring up children in the ways of God.
2. Ezra was a man who set his heart to study the Law of the Lord, and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Israel. Discuss how one can study, do and teach the word and statutes of the Lord.
3. Galatians 6:9–10 (ESV): "And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith." For BMC 80, what are you and your DG doing or planning to do for the 5 expressions? Discuss some extra new things your DG can consider.
4. Witnessing to others about Jesus is a form of teaching. Discuss the merits of witnessing to others using the parable of the prodigal son. Practice using it to witness to each other.
