John 2:1-11 | 9 August 2026 | Rev Dr Aaron Tay

Reflection Questions

1. From John 20, we know that Jesus did many other miracles but John records just 7 miracles in all, and he calls them 'signs' because they point to who Jesus is, like a signpost. The apostle John actually included 7 miracles which were the most supernatural and sensational works that Jesus performed, miracles that no other prophets had done.

Besides the first miracle of Turning Water into Wine (John 2:1-11), the other 6 miracles are recorded in the gospel of John:

- a. John 4:46-54
- b. John 5:1-15
- c. John 6:1-14
- d. John 6:15-21
- e. John 9:1-7
- f. John 11:38-44

Take turns in your DG to read the above 6 sets of Scriptures, and answer the question "Who is Jesus?" from what you learn from the stories of the 6 signs. No need to go too deep in your understanding (we will preach on some of these signs later).

2. Jesus choosing to do His first miracle at a wedding, to bless a wedding couple and their guests, is a reflection of who God is revealed to be in Luke 7:34, Psalm 95:1, Zephaniah 3:17 – that He is Joyful and the Giver of Joy!

SERMON REFLECTIONS

To be like Jesus means that we are to be a people of joy too. What can we do to have (regular) godly joy:

- i. For oneself
- ii. With one's family/friends
- iii. With one's church family
- iv. In one's ministry
- v. In the Lord

What could be the consequence of a church and a people of God who are full of joy, in the area of Evangelism?

3. Jesus turned Water into Wine to help the wedding couple, so that the party could go on! Was it possible that it was a preventable crisis – that the wine did not run out in the first place?

Some crisis that many people (including Christians) face are somewhat preventable, even in important areas.

Discuss what could be done to live wisely so that we can prevent crisis in some important areas such as:

- i. Our Health – Physical, Mental, Emotional, Spiritual
- ii. Our Relationships
- iii. Our Career/vocation
- iv. Our Finances

(Please spend more time discussing about Spiritual Health and our significant Relationships)

4. Pray for each other for God's miracle, either over your own life (if you are currently facing a crisis and willing to share about it), or over the life of someone you know.
