Dear fellow Methodists,

As you attend in your homes and rooms, do prepare your spirit in the same attitude as you would in church; coming into the presence of the God of the universe. Wear appropriate clothing, sit or stand with the liturgy, and sing with your heart and soul in worship.

More and more, we as a community have become the front lines of the battle against the pandemic. The Healthcare System is our last line of defence whilst the war will be won in daily battles by us, disciplined physical distancing and stalwart adherence to the guidelines given by the authorities. It is in the nature of humans and the church to be social and to meet; however, at this time, we have to refrain from this.

It will be a long war ahead, with many battles. It must be fought as a country, but most importantly, it will be won with God's people in prayer on their knees and on their faces. We must unite the faithful to come shoulder-to-shoulder in prayer and petition. Let us as the Methodist Church in Singapore respond to the trumpet call to the front lines and fight with honour and courage.
