SERMON REFLECTIONS

He is Faithful

Matthew 1:1-25 | 27 June 2021

Reflecting on our faith; ways to live out biblical truths we have learnt:

- 1. In Jesus' genealogy, we can find biblical records (beside the names) for 27 of His human ancestors:
 - a. Those who were mostly faithful: Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah, Rahab, Boaz, Ruth, David, Solomon, Abijah, Asa, Jehoshaphat, Uzziah, Hezekiah, Josiah, Zerubbabel, Joseph, Mary.
 - b. Those who were unfaithful, and some even evil: Nahshon, Rehoboam, Jehoram, Ahaz, Manasseh, Amon.

Choose 2 or 3 of Jesus' ancestors (perhaps the unknown ones), learn about their lives, and find out why they were considered faithful/unfaithful and see what God's response to them was.

How can you apply what you have learnt into your own life?

2. The first line of the New Testament proclaims that God is faithful.

In what ways has God been faithful in the Bible (if you remember the stories of Bible characters, such as Abraham, Jacob, David, Josiah, you can use their stories to discern how God has been faithful to them)?

How has God been faithful to you, in your life?
