Faith Builds Faith (the 4 Ps of Faith)

Matthew 9:35 – 10:42 | 22 August 2021

Let's reflect on our faith and ways to live out the biblical truths we have learnt.

1. In your DG, spend a few minutes sharing how you have exercised your faith in the last week, whether in your family, workplace, with your friends and/or in your neighbourhood.
2. In Matthew 9:37-38, our Lord Jesus says that the harvest is plentiful and the workers are few.
 - Who/What is the harvest? Is the harvest plentiful everywhere? If not, where do you think it is currently plentiful?
 - Who are the workers? How can the workers collect the harvest (What are they to do?)
3. Our Lord Jesus warned the disciples about persecution they will face – flogging, arrest, being called to account by those in authority, facing family betrayals, and being hated by people.
 - Share about persecutions Christians are facing in the world today as a result of their faith.
 - Take time to pray for our Christian brothers and sisters who are being persecuted.
4. Look through Matthew 10.
 - What are the promises of Jesus that He is giving to His disciples?
 - Which of His promises is especially meaningful to you? Why?
