Why Trust The Bible?

Matthew 5:17-18 | 18 July 2021

Let's discuss how we can live out our faith.

1. Jesus calls the following people blessed: those who are poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, those persecuted because of righteousness, those who are insulted, persecuted and falsely accused of evil because of Jesus.
 - a. Why do you think Jesus calls these persons blessed? (Focus on 1 or 2.)
 - b. Share a personal experience where you were blessed because of one or more of the areas spoken by Jesus. (E.g. you had mourned and felt the comfort of the Lord.)
- 2a. Why is God's Word so important to the Christian and the Church?
 - b. Share a recent experience regarding the truth/reality and/or power of God's word. (E.g. you acted in a certain way because of God's word, and you were convicted of its truth, reality or power.)
3. Read Matthew 5.
 - a. Discuss one or more areas that speaks to you, as an individual or DG.
 - b. Reflect on a lifestyle change that you want to trust God to help you with. (E.g. because of v22, I will strive not to call anyone "you fool".)
